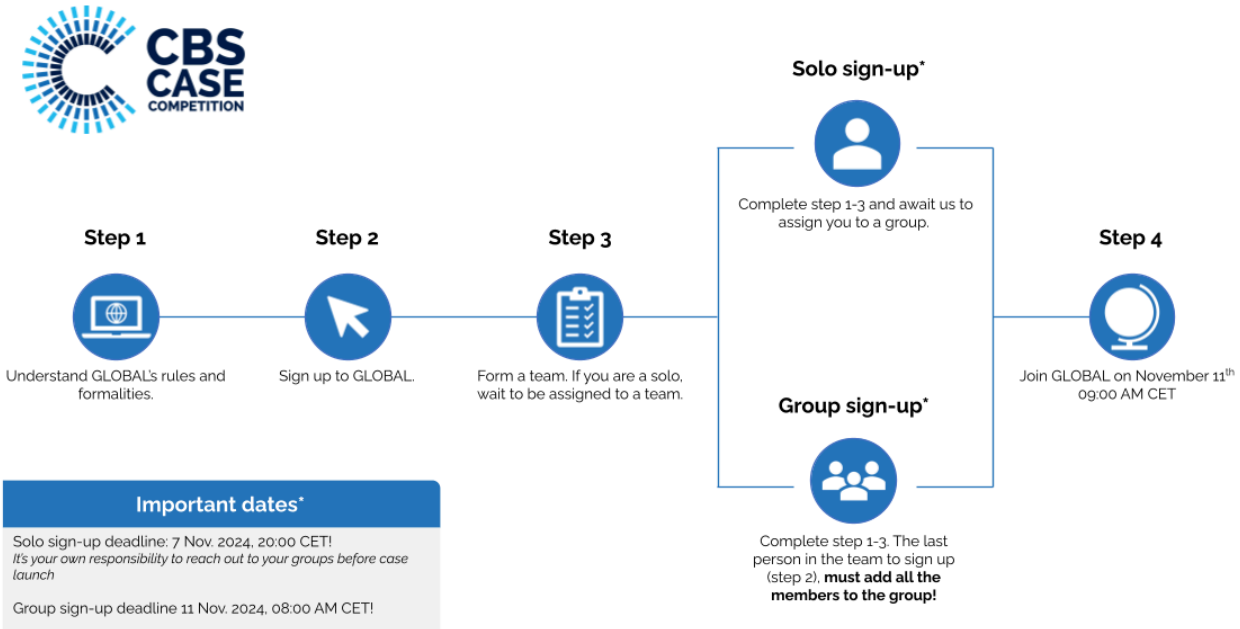

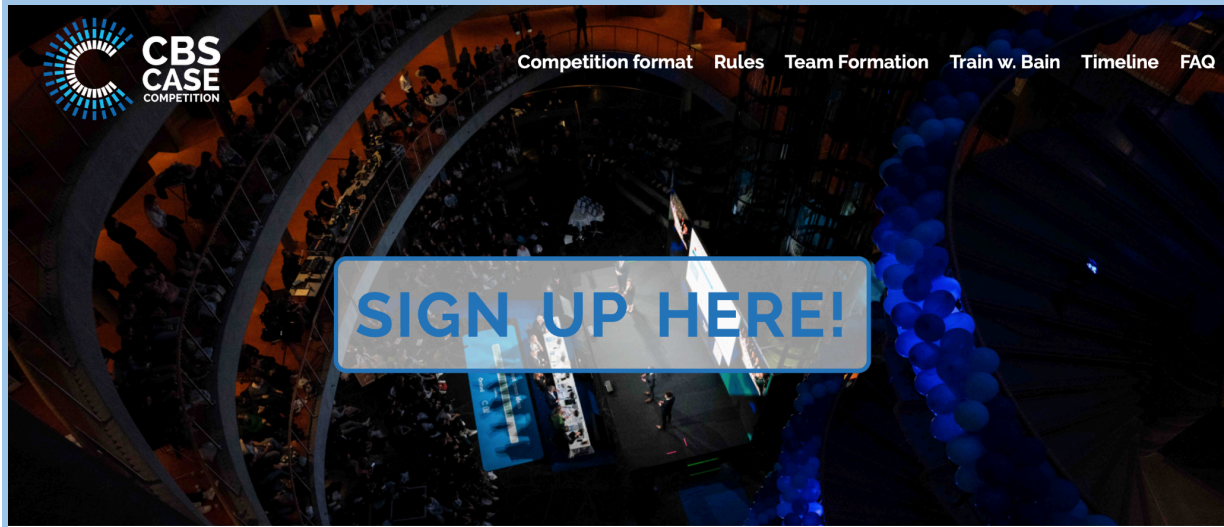

How to create a group

Step 1. Sign up to the Case Competition at signup.casecompetition.com

1. Everyone in your group must complete the sign up by creating a profile. **If you are a solo participant, please see step 5-7.**



2. After completing the sign up, click the button as visualized below. It will direct you to the final stage of the group formation process.

NB: Also, Digital Exam is where the case will be launched (November 11th at 09.00 AM CET) and where you will hand the case in.



Step 2. Forming a group – Invite team members


Once all your team members have completed the sign-up, **one** person must log in and invite all team members to a group.

1. Click on the 'exam' named GLOBAL Case Competition 2024

Step 4. Accessing the case

At case launch on November 11th at 9 AM CET you need to log in to the Digital Exam platform to access the case material and make sure you upload your final answer before November 12th at 9 AM CET.

1. The case file will be visible where the red arrow is pointing.
2. This is also where you have to hand in the case.

Step 5. How to sign up as a solo participant

1. Start by signing up signup.casecompetition.com - the same way as all participants.

Step 6. Await GLOBAL to assign you to a group


2. You have now successfully signed up, and are awaiting to be assigned to a group.
